## Bouncer summoned on Security charge

---

Hotel Bouncer and government employed security guard Dirk Nierop, 47, of Allambie, has been summoned to appear in Waverley Local Court on May 19, 2009, and charged with working without a relevant licence.

Nierop is to appear in court at 9am charged by NSW Police under the Security Industry Act with carrying on a security activity without the security licence at the Doncaster Hotel in Kensington on October 21, 2007.

He allegedly was acting as a crowd controller at the time of the alleged offence.

Police charged and fined him \$5,500, a fine which he has not paid.

Nierop was convicted in the District Court Sydney in 2007 of assaulting Shane Bullock at Collaroy on April 9, 2006.

Then he was acting as a Security Supervisor at the Surf Rock Hotel in Collaroy when Bullock was a Patron of the Hotel.

The court found Nierop guilty of occasioning actual bodily harm but not guilty of maliciously inflicting grievous bodily harm with intent.

Nierop was convicted of the assault on February 23, 2007, but this offence was dismissed by the court on May 8, 2007, and no conviction was recorded.

He is employed as a Security Officer by the NSW Government.
