

Hi Dirk,

My apologies for the delay in responding. In relation to your enquiry, based on the very limited description of the duties you have provided, I would agree it would appear a 1A licence would be appropriate.

The definition of 1A activities, as per Section 11 of the Security Industry Act is "authorises the licensee to patrol, protect, watch or guard any property while unarmed (and whether static or mobile)".

Again, you have asked the question in very broad terms so I would suggest if you require a more specific ruling, you will need to provide more details.
