outrageous

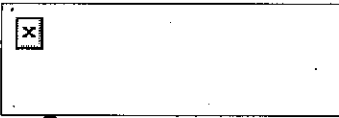
Where does it say he was unconscious during much of the assault????? *-nowhere*

Dear inspector Brownlow

Today is 2 calendar months since our taped meeting at D.Y. police station. I am hoping that you have made some leeway into my complaints regarding the inadequate investigation leading to the charges against me.

If I may quote the letter from Ms Banwell from the ombudsman's office NSW police is required under legislation to

1)-"conduct enquiries into my complaints that are both effective and timely"-

could you please explain what that may mean in actual days/weeks. During our interview when I asked how long that this investigation may take, you gave me a rough guide. ie-5 witnesses would likely take a week, 10 witnesses 2 weeks etc. It has been 9 weeks now so does that mean you have interviewed 45 witnesses?

2)-"if practicable, after conducting inquiries, consult with me before making a decision concerning any action to be taken as a result of my complaint"-

may I ask if there has been any decisions or actions taken as a result of my complaint?

3)-"provide me with advice as to any action taken already taken, and as to the commissioner's decision concerning any action to be taken as a result of my complaint"

May I ask if any action has already been taken, or if the commissioner has made any decision concerning any action to be taken as a result of my complaint?

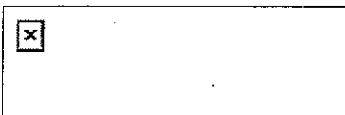
4)-"seek my views on whether I am satisfied with the actions taken or proposed by NSW Police in response to my complaint"

May I ask if my views will be sought when taken or proposed in response to my complaint?

The last paragraph states that; "if at any stage I believe NSW police is failing to carry out it's obligations under the above criteria, I am to advise the ombudsman's office".

At this stage I have no idea if NSW Police is failing to carry out it's obligations as I have had no communication what so ever. Personally, I would think that 2 calendar months would be an "effective and timely" amount of time to adequately investigate this matter. If not, please give me a timeline that you think is "effective and timely"

- 1)-George, Richard or Les not questioned (all top floor security officers)
- 2)-Barman questioned but no notes taken
- 3)-Myself questioned but no notes taken
- 4)-Lack of customer service on the night of arrest-(except Gillian Hough)
- 5)-Revenge attacks on Safehand
- 6)-Shane Bullock not charged with assault
- 7)-Knowingly conspire, tacit approval or negligence of all tiers of station to frame up
- 8)-Confidentiality-personal information spread around town
- 9)-Brinkmanship-CCTV-Licence
- 10)-Abuse of power
- 11)-Extreme prejudice

Specifics

Detective O'Brien

- 1)-Continual revenge raids on Surfrock and other outlets Safehand guard
- 2)-24th June-Skye Bullock made death threats to doorpersons Jenny and Shane while O'Brien there. No action taken
- 3)-Opened an arranged meeting requested by owner of Surfrock due to constant harassment with the words-"it's not because of Dirk"
- 4)-Made deal when bail conditions changed from not work as security officer to not work in licenced premises-gave me hope that I could work for-knowing police would refuse to grant back my licence even with the crowd control component missing-strategy designed to break me financially as now I could not work at as a security officer or in licenced premises in any capacity-even barman or glassy
- 5)-Failure to follow proper procedure in confiscation of licence
- 6)-consistently stating that Safehand "dodgiest company in town"
- 7)-Causing panic to staff of Surfrock on Sunday stating that Shane nearly died twice overnight at the same time Shane was drinking at the football
- 8)-Not taking a blood sample of Shane due to obvious meth-amphetamine abuse

Detective Mooney

- 1)-Refused to except that I had been assaulted-even with Doctors report/witnesses
- 2)-Accused me of hitting Shane "10 times in the face while he was unconscious"
- 3)-Refused to check out my witnesses
- 4)-Arrogant, spiteful, vicious
- 5)-Stated "half the patrons of the hotel had come forward as witnesses"
- 6)-Enjoyed my physical and mental anguish
- 7)-Causing panic to staff of Surfrock on Sunday stating that Shane nearly died twice overnight at the same time he was drinking at the football
- 8)-Not taking blood sample of Shane due to obvious meth-amphetamine abuse
- 9)-Concocter of hysterical antecedent

Constable Gladwin -no notes taken

One further low ranked uniform female officer-no notes taken

High ranking senior officer-no notes taken

Questions

- 1)-Do or have police played in Shane's Rugby league team-the Narrabeen Sharks?
- 2)-Why does it take up to 90 minutes for police to attend (usually with just 1 or 2 officers) when bouncers are in trouble and need backup, (as was the case where I was the star witness for the Crown after performing a citizens arrest due to a glassing, and on at least 30 other occasions), yet are there in huge numbers within minutes as soon as a patron complains about a bouncer?
- 3)-What kind of people would you have to be to force a man who could hardly walk, with a boot full of blood, to walk back to his point of arrest which was kilometres away after midnight?

Observation

Every person involved in this frame up, right up to the final attempt of a whitewash, is undeserving of the power vested in them by the police commissioner of N.S.W., who is hired by a minister who is elected by the people of this state, whom I am a member.
