Hi Dean

I wish to make a formal complaint regarding the actions of police officers from DY police station who have abused their position to pervert the course of justice.

Complaint 1-that DY police lied to the Attorney Generals Department (VCT) by stating that I was convicted of an offence. I was then given 28 days to pay the \$7,000 restitution bill by the VCT. When evidence from my website was produced, they terminated the restitution bill. When I asked where they had got their information from they replied "from hospital and police reports".

Complaint 2-that DY police harassed my employer Tony Rossi (who runs security for Manly Sea Eagle home games) as punishment for complaining to Brett Wall, the officer who ran the Randwick site for the Papal visit. I forged a relationship with Brett (a NSW police officer with integrity) as I was in charge of security for the pope. At the end of the 5 week event, I gave Brett my website. Within a week DY licencing attended Tony's office demanding to see any and all documents relating to me and my employment with his company. He mentioned that they were rifling through his drawers and cabinets while Tony and his partner John from State Protective Services were present. They made it very clear that this was a punishment for employing me. They felt intimidated and threatened.

Complaint 3- (some months after complaint 2) that DY licencing told Tony that if he continued to employ me at any function, that he would be breached. I had written authority from the security Industry Registry to work in the carpark. This letter stating that I was allowed to work was produced by Tony. They reiterated the warning again. If State protective Services employed me again they would be breached (Tony's number is 0419221560)

Complaint 4-that DY police illegally accessed police computers in their vendetta against me to trump up a charge 17 months prior to the alleged misdemeanour. Namely, that they accessed police files to dredge up my name and then illegally used their sister station to lay the charge after I refused to come to DY to be questioned. (Detective Whitefield was the officer they used on this occasion-previously unknown to me) Randwick police had checked my licence on no less than 10 times in the 6 months I worked at the Doncaster-no problem with them at that time.

Complaint 5-that DY police colluded with officers from Randwick to fine me \$5,500 and in the process revoke my licence to stop my gainful employment-the charge were dismissed.
