I refer to your numerous emails sent to the Commission from 13 August 2006 to 4 September 2006.

You will recall that, by letter of 27 June 2006 (our ref: 15981/3), you were advised that the Commission has decided to not investigate your complaint and was seeking your consent to refer it to NSW Police and the NSW Ombudsman. To the PIC and the Ombudsman

Tomorrow I am sending an audio tape of my interview with a very polite and sincere sounding Inspector Brownlow to both your organisations. On this tape are my explosive allegations of widespread corruption and the information needed to prove them. Also enclosed is a media release and my one way correspondence since our meeting. Even though he went out of his way to make me feel as though he was impartial, his station has too much to lose for him to expose so many of his colleagues. I have set a trap. I am totally committed to the cause. I feel so strongly about this matter that I am willing to risk everything to expose this endemic corruption. I have backed myself into a corner by letting the media know what's happening. I know a copy of the media release will make it's way to the police and they will be even more determined to charge me as the only way the media can comment is if the charges are dropped. By doing this, I have forced them to have to continue on with this blatant setup and it's resulting cover up because it involves so many officers. I want to see how far they are willing to go to continue covering up this deepening crisis that they are facing. To see how far the rot goes. What they are willing to do.

How many are sitting in jail now because of these officers? How many would have gone to jail if our paths had not crossed? This is a bitter fight for survival on both sides. If they succeed in destroying me, then who else is there to take up the fight? Many of my brothers in the security industry are semi-illiterate. I owe it to all of them as I am in a unique position to stop them due to my literacy persistence, intelligence, courage, resilience and durability.

I want to believe him but the stakes are too high. This has gone too far now for them to stop. How can he be impartial when he too tried to palm me off with his initial attempt at a whitewash. How can he investigate colleagues of equal or higher rank? I realise these are unconventional tactics but desperate times call for desperate measures.

At best- 3 inspectors, 5 detectives and 8 uniform lower ranked officers are involved in this conspiracy.

At worst? Who knows.

Also enclosed is the follow up emails I have sent with no reply.

They have taken my dignity. They have taken my wealth. They have taken my name and rubbed it in the dirt. They have tried to take my honour, but they will never take my spirit.

The only regret I have with this strategy is that my independent witness/witnesses may be exposed to harm.
